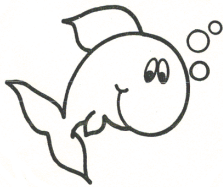




Eagle Eye - Look at the pictures!

- Look at the picture for clues



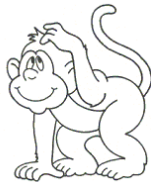
Lips the Fish - Get your lips ready!

- Say the first few sounds of the new word
- Read to the end of sentence and say it again



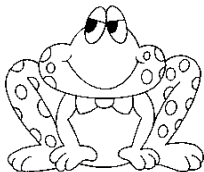
Stretchy Snake - Stretch it out!

- Stretch the word out slowly
- Put the sounds together







Chunky Monkey - Chunk the Word!

- Look for a chunk that you know (-at, -an)
- Look for a word part (-ing, -er)



Skippy Frog - Skip It, Skip It!

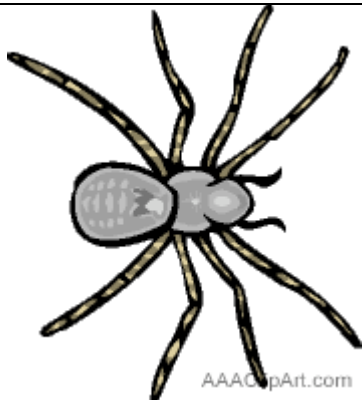
- Skip the word
- Read to the end of the sentence
- Hop back and READ IT, READ

	<p>Tryin' Lion - Try it again!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Try to reread the sentence• Try a word that makes sense
	<p>Helpful Kangaroo - Ask for help!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ask for help (after you have tried all of the other strategies)
	<p>Flippy Dolphin-Flip the vowel sound</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Try another vowel sound if it doesn't sound right.• Flip a short sound into a long sound or visa versa.
	<p>Jabber the Reteller-Synthesize and Retell</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Put the information together and "think" about what you read.• Retell the story or what you learned in your own words.



Visualizing Raccoon

- Put pictures in your head as you read.
- See and think about the story like a movie going on in your head. (What do the characters look like? How do the characters act?)



Spinner the Connecting Spider-Use what you know.

- Connect text-to-text
- Connect text-to-self
- Connect text-to-world

- Make predictions
- Draw Conclusions

Monitor and Fix-it Bear

- I know when I don't understand.
- I use fix-up strategies.



Questioning Owl

- Ask questions before, during, and after reading (who, what, where, when, why?)
